A note from Christy


Hard to believe but 2017 is coming to a close. As we are approaching our 25 year anniversary, we have so much to be thankful for at HopeWest.

DON'T FORGET YOUR TIMESHEFTS!

It is incredibly important that ALL timesheets be turned in to Felicia every month! Patient care timesheets MUST be turned in by the 5th of the following month per our Medicare and Medicaid requirements. Each year, we

must meet our match requirement (staff hours vs. volunteer hours) so that our patients can benefit from these insurance providers. This means that December timesheets must be turned in by mid-January! Please remember to keep timesheets for phone calls. This is particularly important if you are unable to visit your patient for the month, or if the patient denies a visit. One timesheet must be turned in EACH month.
