Camp Good Grief is a weekend summer camp for children and teens entering grades 3 - 8.

The goal of Camp Good Grief is to provide a safe and compassionate environment for children and teens to explore their grief issues with peers and to just have fun! Nearly 50 children and teens, who have all lost someone close to them, attended Camp Good Grief over a warm weekend in July this year. The poem below, written by Sandra Dorr, reflects the complex emotions of campers as their journey begins. This is the first of several poems that will help tell the stories of HopeWest.

Going Up to Camp Good Grief!



We're in a sweaty bus, kids with skinny legs crowded together, some big kids and adults taking up a whole seat. The highway jigs up the mesa, a rippling body of midnight blue we look to every day from this desert valley. The small faces, who have seen someone die, watch the mesa, and we watch the kids, who are the why, from seven to fourteen, some smiling, some wearing a grey shocked look, not talking, huddled alone, no games, no phones. Beads of water trickle down all our backs.

It's little Lillyon's mother, it's the blond wrestler, C. Jay's, stepfather; it's the five girl teens who all lost their fathers. It's Faith with her paperback in front of her face, silent for her seven-year-old brother, it's the Irish Indian boy staring out the window mourning both grandfathers, and the calm pretty girl, Pearadyce, her mom still in prison, father gone, her brother-in-law's body, which police abandoned. Add in her two nieces with dark moist eyes, they're on this bus, too, with all the families who can't talk about death, whom the kids can't talk to, these shadows ride this bus too.

We gain altitude, travel through tall clay hills where nothing will ever grow again, then the shining Colorado, trees hanging like jewelry over the water, and Cathy, the bus driver in braids, brakes to let some "littles" breathe in shade. She takes the microphone and asks for quiet so she can hear the train as we near a railroad crossing: the warm bus stops just before the tracks. Littles and bigs crane their necks to look we hold our breath, something within approaching, memory coalescing like buttonhooks.



Off we go again, the bus shifting up a dusty road, white CGG waterbottles emptied, bouncing like bowling pins down the aisles, we're chatting, we buddies, each here for each child, looking into their eyes, asking about school, about their favorite things, yeah I was a tomboy too just like you, sure, yeah I love that guy too, didja know they traded him to the Phillies last year, we're getting around to it, biting our mouths to see if words will come now.

if they will look out the window, or say it was in January or I was too little or I don't remember anything, if she might put her hands over her face, if his lower lip starts to guiver, if they might turn away, and still we breathe and wait until he recites in a monotone the name, the date, and she looks away, whispers, it was last year my mom came home late, and now the air's just a little cooler, we rise higher, pass small old stone houses,

the road littered with pine cones, the bus brushing piñon, we see a meadow that feels round, a forest rushing up to the sky, and we all breathe in green, feel the bus sway down a gravel road. Speed Limit 5 shows through the trees: bright white buildings with solid timbers, tall swingsets, big basalt boulders, a deck smoking with the sweet rich smell of barbecue. The bus slows under a great leafless cottonwood standing sentry, just two twisted limbs left, thrown out on each side as if the old tree's dancing, and little Kiana points and cries out, "It's welcoming us!"

Generous donation brightens patients day


